## Carpet Bonnet Cleaning Of Carpet

### Why Bonnet Clean?

Bonnet cleaning is a interim maintenance method for carpet care. Bonnet cleaning does not deep clean carpet. It only surface cleans. Bonnet cleaning allows a longer period of time to elapse before deep cleaning is required.

#### Equipment / Materials Needed:

- Rotary floor machine with pad holder
- Bonnet carpet cleaning pads.
- Bonnet Cleaning Chemical / Spotter (Husky 1110)
- 1 Gallon Tank Sprayer or wringer bucket.

### Procedure: Bonnet Cleaning of Carpet.

1. Vacuum carpet thoroughly and pre-spot.
2. Position wet floor signs.
3. Mix bonnet cleaner solution according to manufactures directions.
4. Attach pad holder, with bonnet pad centered, to rotary machine.
5. Spray solution on carpet in three foot widths holding the sprayer approximately knee high.
6. "Buff" carpet with bonnet working across the carpet in a slow, side to side motion. Move slowly backward, making sure to overlap the cleaned area.
7. Flip the bonnet pad over as they become soiled.
8. Keep bonnet pad clean by washing in clear water and wringing or change pads if they are too dirty.
9. Use fans to speed up drying.
10. When dry, vacuum area.
11. Clean up equipment and return to storage.

#### Fact:

Most of the carpet we come into contact with in today's commercial use are Nylon. In the United States Nylon represents **75% of the carpet use today**
